PhD Entrance Test - (H-PET) Notification

HSNC University, Mumbai, invites applications for the PhD. Programmes offered by the Constituent Colleges/Schools of the University for the academic year 2026-27.

1. Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

- A) Candidates having a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Masters degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade B in the UGC 10-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever a grading system is followed), M.Phil. Degree of Indian institution or equivalent degree from a foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognised or authorised by an Authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

- B) A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, shall be allowed for those belonging to reserved categories/Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per policies of the Government of Maharashtra prescribed from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree before 19th September 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.
- C) M. Phil. students of any recognised University whose M.Phil. dissertation has been evaluated and the viva voce is pending may be admitted to the PhD programme.

2. Process of Admission:

Candidate shall be admitted to PhD programmes by a two-stage process through:

A) Entrance Examination:

- a) H-PET Entrance Examination, which shall be a qualifying test.
- b) The test H-PET comprises two Papers:
 - i) Paper I: Research Methodology and Research Aptitude: 50 Marks
 - ii) Paper II: Subject Specific: 50 Marks
- c) The H-PET shall carry 100 Marks for the duration of two hours.
- d) Qualifying marks shall be 50% of the aggregate, taking Paper I and Paper II together.
- e) All questions shall be multiple choice; each correct answer carries one mark with no negative marking systems.
- f) Relaxation of 5% of Marks, from 50% to 45%, shall be allowed for those categories of candidates as per policies of the Government of Maharashtra prescribed from time to time.

B) Personal Interview:

For candidates qualifying in H-PET and Candidates exempted from the Entrance Examination, a personal interview will be conducted as per the procedure prescribed in due course. (Please visit the university website: www.hsncu.edu.in)

3. Exemption from appearing in H-PET:

The Candidates fulfilling at least one of the following conditions will be exempted from the Entrance Examination:

- A) Candidates qualified with a valid score in UGC-NET (Including JRF)/ UGC-CSIR NET (Including JRF)/ SLET/ SET/ GATE/ GPAT/ CSIR/ ICAR/ ICMR/ DBT and DST Inspire fellowship/ Joint Graduate Entrance Examination for Biology and Interdisciplinary Life Science (JGEEBILS) or Teacher fellowship holders will be exempted from the Entrance Test.
- B) Students who have passed the PET examination conducted by any recognised University.
- C) Candidates who have passed M. Phil. A programme from any recognised University will be exempt from the Entrance Test for the PhD programme, provided the MPhil meets UGC guidelines.
- D) PhD degree holder from any recognised University who wishes to pursue a PhD at this University.

 - c) Photocopy of M.Phil. Degree Certificate from any recognised University.

7. General Instructions:

- A) Candidates in the final year of the qualifying examination of the course are allowed to apply for the H-PET. However, the admission of such candidates is subject to their passing the qualifying examination.

- B) It is the responsibility of the applicant to fulfil the eligibility conditions and comply with the admission requirements. If at any stage it is noticed that the candidate or important material facts have made a false claim, have been concealed and/ or the candidate is not eligible, his candidature shall be liable for cancellation at any stage.
- C) In case of any grievance or dispute, the decision of the University shall be final and binding on all.
- D) Candidates need NOT submit printouts/hardcopy of applications or documents to the University after completing the online application submission. However, it is necessary to carry the original documents at the time of the Personal Interview.
- E) Application forms submitted after the due date or incomplete application forms without uploading required documents will be rejected without assigning any reason. The University will not entertain any correspondence in this regard.
- F) The request for change in any information submitted in the online form will not be considered.
- G) The online registration process will be treated as complete only after the required certificates and application are uploaded on the link provided.

H-CET Guidelines:

1. Eligibility:

A) MBA:

- a) Graduates/postgraduates with Bachelor's/ Postgraduate degree with at least 50% (for General Category) and 45% for Reserved and Physically / Differently abled candidates in any discipline (e.g. Engineering-Technology, Science, Commerce, Management, Accounts, etc.) from any university recognised by UGC/ AICTE/ AIU or equivalent are eligible to apply.

- b) The percentages may be relaxed for the candidates from the Armed Forces or their children.
- c) There is no age limit for applying.
- d) Fresh Graduates/postgraduates awaiting final result declaration can also apply and appear for H-CET. The qualified and shortlisted candidates will be provisionally admitted.

B) BBA/ BMS/ BCA:

- a) Passed 10+2 (HSC) or its equivalent examination (as per AICTE APH 2025-2028)
- b) Candidates appearing for 10+2 (HSC) or its equivalent examination are also eligible to appear for H-CET

2. Selection Criteria:

- A) CAT, XAT, GMAT, C-MAT, MAT, SNAP, MH-CET or any State CET scores may be considered. The aforesaid scores should be current and valid.
- B) Candidates not having any of the above scores will be required to appear for H-CET. In case of multiple test scores, a candidate can submit his or her best score. Candidates can also appear for H-CET to improve their Test Scores. HSNCU will prepare a scale for comparison of Test Scores conducted by various agencies mentioned above. H-LAT Guidelines:

1. Eligibility:

A) LLB:

- a) Graduates/postgraduates with Bachelor's / Postgraduate degree with at least 45% marks or equivalent grade for General Category candidates, 42% marks or equivalent grade for SEBC/OBC category and 40% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST category candidates in any discipline (e.g. Engineering-Technology, Science, Commerce, Management, Accounts, etc.) from any university recognised by UGC/ AICTE / AIU or equivalent are eligible to apply. However, there is no age limit to apply.

- b) Fresh Graduates/postgraduates awaiting final result declaration can also apply and appear for H-LAT-1. The qualified and shortlisted candidates will be provisionally admitted.

B) LLM:

The eligibility criteria for admission to LL.M. (Two-Year) Degree course shall be as follows:

- a) The minimum qualification for a candidate making an application for admission to the LL.M. Degree Program offered by HSNC University is LL.B. degree (3 year or 5 year) of HSNC University or any other Indian or Foreign University recognized as equivalent by HSNC University.
- b) For General Category LL.B degree (3 year or 5 year) with at least 45% marks or equivalent grade, for SEBC/OBC category 42% marks or equivalent grade and for SC/ST category candidates 40% marks or equivalent grade.
- c) Candidates who have appeared for the Final Semester Examinations of 3 year or 5-year LL.B. Program from HSNC University or any other recognised University are eligible to apply for H-LAT-2.
- d) Candidates who are currently pursuing LL.M. in any other University will be required to cancel their current LL.M. admission if they want to appear for H-LAT-2.
- e) There is no upper age limit for appearing for the H-LAT-2.
- f) The results of the Entrance Test are valid for one academic year only (2026-2027), and the candidate must apply for admission within the validity period.

- A) Graduates/postgraduates with Bachelor's / Postgraduate degree with at least 50% (for General Category) and 45% for Reserved and Physically / Differently abled candidates in any discipline (e.g. Engineering-Technology, Science, Commerce, Management, Accounts, etc.) from any university recognised by UGC/ AICTE / AIU or equivalent are eligible to apply.

- B) The percentages may be relaxed for the candidates from the Armed Forces or their children.
- C) There is no age limit for applying.
- D) Fresh Graduates/postgraduates awaiting final result declaration can also apply and appear for H-MCET. The qualified and shortlisted candidates will be provisionally admitted.

2. Selection Criteria:

- A) CAT, XAT, GMAT, C-MAT, MAT, SNAP, MH-CET or any State CET scores may be considered. The aforesaid scores should be current and valid.
- B) Candidates who have not appeared for any of the above examinations will be required to appear for H-MCET. This year, candidates can also appear for H-TCET to improve their Test Scores.

6 Common Information

1. Validity Period:

The results of the Entrance Test will be valid for that one academic year only and the candidate must apply within this period for admission.

2. Instructions for Online Examination:

- A) Personal Laptop or Desktop computer or Smartphone in working condition with a good quality camera. In case your desktop does not have a camera, use a USB camera.
- B) Browser: Latest version of Google Chrome.
- C) Internet speed should be at least 10 Mbps for better results.
- D) Mobile Phone user must disable all notifications, such as WhatsApp, SMS, and email, before the commencement of the examination.
- E) You may not be able to appear for the exam if the web camera attached to your system is not functional.
- F) Use of headphones and phone calls is not permissible during the exam.
- G) Breaks are not allowed during the examination. The examination session is auto/image proctored, and any physical movement by students or disruption to the examination login is recorded and will be considered suspicious activity. For five or more such activities, the reports of such students will be forwarded to the University/College's unfair means committee.
- H) You are required to turn off all notifications and pop-ups to complete the paper successfully. If you receive TEN notifications, your examination will be automatically terminated.
- I) As you are not allowed to leave your seat, keep all necessary items, such as rough sheets, a simple calculator, and a pen, with you.
