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1 H-CET

Notification for H-CET-1 (for MBA) and H-CET-2 (for BBA/BCA/BMS)

HSNCU Common Entrance Test (H-CET) is one of the entrance examinations accepted for admission to the Two-Year MBA and Three / Four Years BBA/ BCA/ BMS Programmes offered under HSNC University, Mumbai. This entrance exam (H-CET) will be conducted ONLINE. The schedule for H-CET is as follows:

H-CET Guidelines:

1. Eligibility:

A) MBA:

- a) Graduates/postgraduates with Bachelor's/ Postgraduate degree with at least 50% (for General Category) and 45% for Reserved and Physically / Differently abled candidates in any discipline (e.g. Engineering-Technology, Science, Commerce, Management, Accounts, etc.) from any university recognised by UGC/ AICTE/ AIU or equivalent are eligible to apply.
- b) The percentages may be relaxed for the candidates from the Armed Forces or their children.
- c) There is no age limit for applying.
- d) The students awaiting final result declaration can also apply and appear for H-CET. The qualified and shortlisted candidates will be provisionally admitted.

B) BBA/ BMS/ BCA:

- a) Passed 10+2 (HSC) or its equivalent examination (as per AICTE APH 2025-2028)
- b) Candidates appearing for 10+2 (HSC) or its equivalent examination are also eligible to appear for H-CET

2. Selection Criteria:

- A) CAT, XAT, GMAT, C-MAT, MAT, SNAP, MH-CET or any State CET scores may be considered. The aforesaid scores should be current and valid.
- B) Candidates not having any of the above scores will be required to appear for H-CET. In case of multiple Test Scores, a candidate can submit his or her best score. Candidates can also appear for H-CET to improve their Test Scores. The best normalised score among accepted examinations shall be considered. HSNCU will prepare a scale for comparison of Test Scores conducted by various agencies mentioned above. Such details will be placed on the admission brochures, material and HSNCU website fairly and transparently.
- C) Appropriate weightage as shown below will be given to various selection criteria, including: scrutiny of application forms, Test Scores, group discussion, written essay and personal interview as applicable.

1. Eligibility:

Passed 10+2 examination with Physics/ Mathematics/ Chemistry/ Computer Science/ Electronics/ Information Technology/ Biology/ Informatics Practices/ Biotechnology/ Obtained at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to the reserved category) in the above subjects taken together. OR Passed D.Voc. Stream in the same or allied sector.

2. Selection Criteria:

- A) MHT-CET or JEE (main) examination scores will be considered. The aforesaid scores should be current and valid.
- B) Candidates who have not appeared for any of the above examinations will be required to appear for H-TCET. This year, candidates can also appear for H-TCET to improve their Test Scores.

Notification for H-LAT-1 (for BBA LLB, BA LLB and LLB) and H-LAT-2 (for LLM)

Candidates are hereby informed that the HSNC University Law Aptitude Test (H-LAT) will be conducted ONLINE for admission to the UG LL.B. Three/Five Year Law Program (H-LAT-1) and for admission to the Two Year LL.M. Program (H-LAT-2) offered under HSNC University, Mumbai at HSNC University, Mumbai.

H-LAT Guidelines:

1. **Eligibility** (As per the Bar Council of India (BCI) Rules of Legal Education):

A) BBA LLB and BA LLB:

- a) Pass 10+2 or equivalent from a recognised Board.
- b) Should have obtained 45% aggregate marks for General Category candidates, 42% aggregate marks for SEBC/ OBC category and 40% aggregate marks for SC/ ST category.

B) LLB:

- a) Graduates/postgraduates with Bachelor's / Postgraduate degree with at least 45% marks or equivalent grade for General Category candidates, 42% marks or equivalent grade for SEBC/OBC category and 40% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST category candidates in any discipline (e.g. Engineering-Technology, Science, Commerce, Management, Accounts, etc.) from any university recognised by UGC/ AICTE / AIU or equivalent are eligible to apply. However, there is no age limit to apply.

- b) The students awaiting final result declaration can also apply and appear for H-LAT-1. The qualified and shortlisted candidates will be provisionally admitted.

C) LLM:

The eligibility criteria for admission to LL.M. (Two-Year) Degree course shall be as follows:

- a) The minimum qualification for a candidate making an application for admission to the LL.M. Degree Program offered by HSNC University is LL.B. degree (3 year or 5 year) of HSNC University or any other Indian or Foreign University recognised as equivalent by HSNC University.
- b) For General Category LL.B degree (3 year or 5 year) with at least 45% marks or equivalent grade, for SEBC/OBC category 42% marks or equivalent grade and for SC/ST category candidates 40% marks or equivalent grade.
- c) Candidates who have appeared for the Final Semester Examinations of 3-year or 5-year LL.B. Program from HSNC University or any other recognised University are eligible to apply for H-LAT-2.
- d) Candidates who are currently pursuing LL.M. in any other University will be required to cancel their current LL.M. admission if they want to appear for H-LAT-2.
- e) There is no upper age limit for appearing for the H-LAT-2.
- f) The results of the Entrance Test are valid for one academic year only (2026-2027), and the candidate must apply for admission within the validity period.

2. Syllabus and Selection Criteria:

A) H-LAT-1:

- CLAT (Common Law Admission Test);
- LSAT (Law School Admission Test); and
- MH-CET Law (Maharashtra Common Entrance Test Law) scores may be considered.
- The aforesaid scores should be current and valid.

Candidates not having any of the above scores will be required to appear for H-LAT. In cases of multiple Test Scores, a candidate can submit their best score. Candidates can also appear for the H-LAT to improve their Test Scores. HSNC University, Mumbai, will prepare a scale for comparing Test Scores conducted by the various agencies mentioned above. Such details will be included in the admission brochures, materials, and the HSNCU website fairly and transparently.

B) H-LAT-2:

- a) Admission to the two-year LL.M. program shall be made strictly in accordance with the merit list of the H-LAT-2 entrance examination 2026, and the reservation policy of the Government of Maharashtra and the Rules and Regulations of the HSNC University.
- b) Minimum Passing Marks in Entrance:

1.	General Category	40 Marks
2.	SEBC/OBC Category	35 Marks
3.	SC/ST Category	30 Marks

- c) Tie Breaker Rule: In case of equal marks in H-LAT -2, the break of the tie shall be applied by the following procedure and order as under:
- Percentage in LL.B.
 - Percentage in 12th
 - Higher Age
- d) List of entrance exams which are exempted from H-LAT-2:
- CLAT PG Examination (Common Law Admission Test for Post Graduate)
 - CUET LL.M. Examination (Common University Entrance Test for the Master of Laws (LL.M.) program)
 - University of Mumbai LL.M. Common Entrance Test (LL.M. CET)

Candidates not having any of the above scores will be required to appear for H-LAT-2. In case of multiple Test Scores, a candidate can submit his or her best score. Candidates can also appear for the H-LAT-2 to improve their Test Score.

- e) A candidate found using any unfair means shall be debarred from the examination.

4 Common Information

1. Validity Period:

The results of the Entrance Test will be valid for that one academic year only and the candidate must apply within this period for admission.

2. Instructions for Online Examination:

- A) Personal Laptop or Desktop computer, or Smartphone in working condition with a good quality camera. In case your desktop does not have a camera, use a USB camera.
- B) Browser: Latest version of Google Chrome.
- C) Internet speed should be at least 10 Mbps for better results.
- D) Mobile phone users must disable all notifications, such as WhatsApp, SMS, and email, before the commencement of the examination.
- E) You may not be able to appear for the exam if the web camera attached to your system is not functional.
- F) Use of headphones and phone calls is not permissible during the exam.
- G) Breaks are not allowed during the examination. The examination session is auto/image proctored, and any physical movement by students or disruption to the examination login is recorded and will be considered suspicious activity. For five or more such activities, the reports of such students will be forwarded to the University/College's unfair means committee.
- H) You are required to turn off all notifications and pop-ups to complete the paper successfully. If you receive TEN notifications, your examination will be automatically terminated.
- I) As you are not allowed to leave your seat, keep all necessary items, such as rough sheets, a simple calculator, and a pen, with you.
- J) If your computer is not responding or there is a cut of the power supply during the exam, you need to re-log in with your login credentials; all attempted questions will be saved in the database only if you click the SAVE button and you can resume from where you left the exam.
- K) Do not use the Alt-Tab, mouse or any other device to shift from the examination screen to any other screen while attempting the objective examination.
- L) Ensure that your face has been visible throughout the examination; otherwise, it will be considered as misconduct and will be reported to the university. If the webcam is not functioning, your examination will be considered null and void. The proctor will monitor your exam activity, and your exam will be terminated if you engage in any unfair practice.
- M) The non-observance of the said rules will amount to a case of malpractice and will be reported to the grievance committee for decision.
